Gospel Reading: 1 Corinthians 12: 12-31a.

(Join in reading the bold print. Unity and Diversity in the Body)

12 Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. **13 For we were all baptized by[a] one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.** 14 Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many. **15 Now if the foot should say, “Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body,” it would not for that reason stop being part of the body.** 16 And if the ear should say, “Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,” it would not for that reason stop being part of the body. **17 If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?** 18 But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. **19 If they were all one part, where would the body be?** 20 As it is, there are many parts, but one body. **21 The eye cannot say to the hand, “I don’t need you!” And the head cannot say to the feet, “I don’t need you!”** 22 On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, 23 **and the parts that we think are less honourable we treat with special honour. And the parts that are unpresentable are treated with special modesty,** 24 while our presentable parts need no special treatment. But God has put the body together, giving greater honour to the parts that lacked it, **25 so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.** 26 If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. **27 Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.** 28 And God has placed in the church first of all **apostles,** second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, of helping, of guidance, and of different kinds of tongues. **29 Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work miracles?** 30 Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues[b]? Do all interpret? **31 Now eagerly desire the greater gifts. Love Is Indispensable and yet I will show you the most excellent way.**
