Structure, Governance and Management

Governing Document

The Church is an unincorporated entity and is administered in accordance with the terms of the Deed of Constitution (Unitary Form).

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

Members of the Kirk Session are Charity Trustees. The Kirk Session Members are the Elders of the Church and are chosen from those members of the Church who are considered to have the appropriate gifts and skills. No trustees are paid expenses or remuneration. The Minister, who is a member of the Kirk Session, is elected by the congregation and and inducted by the Presbytery.

Organisational Structure

The Kirk Session is responsible for the spiritual and financial affairs within the Church and meets at least 4 times a year.

Objectives and Activities

The Church of Scotland is Trinitarian in doctrine, Reformed in tradition, and Presbyterian in polity. It exists to glorify God and to work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom throughout the world. As a national Church it acknowledges a distinctive call and duty to bring the ordinances of religion to the people in every parish of Scotland through a territorial ministry. It co-operates with other churches in various ecumenical bodies in Scotland and beyond.

The Church meets on alternate Sundays in Findhorn and Kinloss. It carries out various social events throughout the year and allows halls at Findhorn and Kinloss to be used by local community groups.

Achievements and Performance

Kinloss Church continues to make the Culbin Room, Califer Room, and the Church available to many local groups. The year started off very quietly but built-up steadily to previous levels and included some new groups. Findhorn Hall was not used during the year, partly because it depends upon the Village Centre for much of it's business and they were not operating during most of the year. The Committee however continued to raise match-funding to fulfil a large refurbishment project which is intended to benefit the community.

This year has obviously been very challenging for the communities of Kinloss and Findhorn and this has been reflected in our activities which were curtailed at the begining of the year.

Financial Review

The finances have again suffered a very poor year due to the ongoing pandemic situation. Our main income comes from the rental of Kinloss Hall to many local groups. The income is crucial to the running of the General Account so the account has suffered a loss. We had to draw upon our reserves at 121 George Street to support the General Account which had outgoing commitments of Stipend, Insurance and Fabric payments.

£29,496 was drawn from the Consolidated Fabric Fund Revenue Account with most of the expenditure being used on a new boiler and maintenance of the Manse prior to our new Minister arriving. The Consolidated Fabric Fund Revenue Account still has a healthy balance due to the Manse rental payments of £5,984 being paid into it during the year.

Our investments which are held at 121 George Street also suffered. The Growth Fund and the Fabric Fund both increased modestly but the Income Fund, General Purposes Fund and Findhorn Development Fund all decreased. Overall the investments did increase marginally. In addition the dividends paid into our accounts were greatly reduced.

This is shown in the accounts.

Reserves Policy

It is the Trustees' policy to hold reserves of approximately six months expenditure including designated funds. At the year end the Church held unrestricted cash funds of £47,534 of which £6,030 has been designated for fabric fund, £11,089 for refurbishment of Findhorn Church, and £16,053 for continuing development of Kinloss Church. The remaining balance of £14,362 represents about 4 months general expenditure and the Trustees will authorise transfer of funds from the designated Church funds to the General fund for running costs as required.

Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities

The members of the Kirk Session must prepare financial statements, which give sufficient details to enable an appreciation of the transactions of the Church during the financial year. The Members of the Kirk Session are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which, on request, must reflect the financial position of the Church at that time. This must be done to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005, the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Regulations Anent Congregational Finance approved by the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2007. They are responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Church and must take reasonable steps for the prevention and/or detection of fraud and other irregularities.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Kinloss and Findhorn Parish Church

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2021 which comprise the receipts and payments account, statement of balances and the related notes.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulation 2006 (as amended). Basis of independent examiner's statement
